New FAQ Navigation

Today the biggest thing I have to announce is a dramatically improved FAQ document. We have now included a clickable index in the left-hand column when you view the FAQ so you can easily navigate to any subject you're interested in.

The FAQ still remains downloadable as always, and I believe the clickable index feature will remain in the downloaded file as well. (No promises on that, though, as I have the full version of Acrobat, so maybe the index function doesn't work with the freeware reader). Anyway, this new clickable index should prove a great help in finding just what you're looking for quickly.

Hydra, Intruder, Matrix and Mini-BBX RockSim Files

I've made some edits to the RockSim RKT files for the 4 new kits we just released. We've got the new ones posted on our RockSim page (it has a -2 in the filename so you'll know it's the second/new version). You'll want the new ones as the flight simulations on various motors are different than the originals. Basically I had to edit a couple fin thicknesses, so the flights are now a little different. Some flights only changed by 5-10 feet, where others changed by over 100! I also edited the Motor Recommendations Chart to reflect the new altitudes from re-running the sims.
