Introducing the very unique, military-style MR1. It would be easy to envision our ground troops using similar designs on the battle field. The MR1 stands 25" tall. The major diameter is 3" while the minor diameter is 2.1" tubing. The MR1 weighs in at 24 ozs., and comes with a 24" chute. It is designed to fly on high impulse F and G motors for Pre-Cert flights and most H and I motors for Cert 1 flights. The MR1 comes with a 29mm motor mount standard, but is available with a 38mm mount for no extra charge; specify "38mm" in the Comments section of the order form. (To use 38mm mount with 29mm motors, purchase the optional ADPTR-38/29. Order the MR-1 on the *Sport Fliers* page of the webstore at www.publicmissiles.com.

AGM-256 "Pit Bull"



True Air Force-like styling is sure to command attention on the flight line! The Pit Bull is 35" tall and 2.6" in diameter. The Pit Bull weighs in at 29 oz., and comes with a 30" chute. This kit is designed to fly on high impulse F and G motors for Pre-Cert flights and most H and I motors for Cert 1 flights. Comes standard with a 38mm motor mount. The Pit Bull comes with a 38mm motor mount (for 29mm motors, purchase the optional ADPTR-38/29). Rocket shown with Linear Rail Lugs LRL-10-2; order separately on the *Hardware Page*.
